Assembly Instructions

Print out 13 copies of the envelope template page. I like to print it on card stock so the envelopes are more durable.

Print out one copy of the remaining pages.

Cut on the inside of the lines for the envelopes and then fold the tabs in towards the middle. Place some glue on the tabs and then fold the bottom up.

Cut out the star and flower like shapes.

Cut out the number circles.

Glue the number circles to the flower and star shapes. We glue the number 25 to the star shape.







Once the number circles are glued onto the star and flower shapes. Using a little glue in the middle of the back of the flower shape attach them to the envelope.







If you only glue in the middle the shape will stand up a little off the envelope.






We arrange them in a tree shape with the number 25 at the top and attach them to a door or onto a board. You can arrange the envelopes in any shape you like.







There you have your own Advent calendar.


















